



# Uniform Specifications

## Formal Uniform

- Ladies**
- White cotton/poly blouse (no logo required) and black tie
  - Cardigan, vest, v-neck sweater or jacket with CHS logo
  - Black dress slacks, black 'A'-line skirts or approved kilt
  - Natural coloured leotards, solid or nylons
  - Single color knee socks (black)
  - Black blazers may be substituted for sweater

- Men**
- White cotton/poly dress shirt (no logo required) and black tie
  - Cardigan, vest, v-neck sweater or jacket with CHS logo
  - Black dress pants (Wool Blend or Cotton/Poly)
  - Black socks
  - Black blazers may be substituted for sweater

## Casual Uniform

- White tops, shirts, blouses (with logo) and black pants/slacks or 'A' line cut skirts (as listed above).
- The white tops are available at our uniform supplier.
- Students are free to select any white top that has a CHS logo on it (excluding Phys. Ed. wear) for casual day.
- The black 'A'-line skirts and pants/slacks will be purchased by students at any retail outlet of their choosing.
- Denim, leather and spandex (tight form fitting materials) will not be permitted.
- These pants and skirts are meant to be in keeping with CHS' high standards and teachers will monitor, on a case by case basis, if student choices have been appropriate.
- Concordia "Pride Wear" (team & co-curricular attire), may be worn on casual days and game days by team members only. Appropriate shirts (casual or formal) must be worn with this attire.

## Uniform Footwear

- Casual Uniform**
- Dark sandals may be worn with casual wear.
  - Athletic shoes may be worn with the casual uniform. Shoes should be non-marking and predominately black, white or navy.

- Formal Uniform**
- Casual dress shoes
  - Non-scuffing soles
  - Black leather or canvas
  - Maximum two-inch heel

- Physical Education**
- Non-marking athletic shoes should be worn during P.E. classes.

## Enforcement

Students not in the appropriate uniform will be asked:

1. to return to dormitory or home to change, or
2. Parents may be called to bring the appropriate uniform items to the school.

If a student continually disregards the uniform policy, parents will be called to the school for a conference and students may face disciplinary action.

## Appearance
